



Motivational Speaking Script Preparation Instructions

Purpose: Motivational Speaking scripts should contain the text of the student's original speech for the purposes of accountability. Motivational Speaking is unique in that the students should follow their script but do not have to deliver it word for word. Though the speech must be original, it may consist of support from outside sources. The sources of any contributing information must be formally cited so that credit may be given where credit is due. The Script Preparation Instructions below will assist with that process and the student should complete them to the best of his ability. No student should be disqualified from tournament competition due to a script formatting error.

1. The speech must be an original work, written by the student.
2. The student must submit a typewritten hard copy of his speech.
3. All direct quotations must be underlined.
4. No more than 30% of the speech may consist of direct quotations.
5. A Citation Page must be created on a separate sheet of paper at the end of the speech. (Use www.easybib.com to help document and format each source on the Citation Page.)
6. All direct quotations must be cited on a final Citation Page.
7. Additional sources must also be cited on the final Citation Page.
8. Although direct quotations and indirect references are verbally cited, they may also need to be documented in the text of the speech. (Use http://media.easybib.com/ebook/mla_parenthetical.pdf to help you determine what kind of citation will be needed.)
9. Copyrighted Expository images must also be cited on the final Citation Page.
10. A current Script Submission Form should be submitted with the speech script at each tournament.

If for some reason the student is unable to comply with the script submission requirements, or if he is missing some required element, a brief explanation should be attached to the Script Submission Form for consideration by tournament administration.



Motivational Speaking Script Submission Checklist

1. Typewritten copy of the script:

- a. Speech script is typewritten.
- b. Direct quotations are underlined.
- c. Citation Page is included on a separate sheet of paper at the end of the speech.

2. Script Submission Form:

- a. Current Script Submission Form is attached.
- b. Parent and/or coach signatures are included.
- c. The number of total words is recorded.
- d. The number of directly quoted words is recorded.
- e. The percentage of quoted words is recorded.
- f. No more than 30% of the speech consists of direct quotations.
